

How mergers and acquisitions impact clinical data

Q-Centrix surveyed healthcare leaders about their experiences going through mergers and/or acquisitions (M&As). Results highlighted the importance of prioritizing clinical data during these transitions.



How M&As impacted clinical data:

- 47% Changes in data governance and access
- 39% Improved data sharing and collaboration
- 33% Adoption of new data management tools or systems
- 39% Centralized data management systems
- 33% Challenges integrating data between systems
- 33% Working with new third-party clinical data management vendors



How clinical data management was prioritized during M&As:

- 50% of respondents felt clinical data management was only **somewhat** prioritized during the transition
- 40% felt it was prioritized adequately
- 10% felt it was **not** prioritized adequately



Survey administered in July and August 2023 with 39 respondents who experienced a merger or acquisition.
